Operating Highlights - Payana

Number Impacted- 150

Financial Support: 15 Lacs

Empowering Adolescent Girls through Education & Holistic Development

Payana is a transformative initiative designed to support adolescent girls on their journey to academic excellence and personal growth. Through this program, we aim to nurture confidence and independence among girls aged 13 to 21 years, providing educational support from Grade 9 through to their degree programs. The selection process includes student identification, counseling sessions with their mothers, home visits, and enrollment into the Payana group.

Scholarship & Program Investment

• 150 students received scholarships this year, totaling INR 15 lakh, with an additional program cost of INR 3 lakh.

Comprehensive Training & Skill Development

Upon enrollment, students participate in a variety of **training programs** aimed at their holistic development:

- Yoga for Menstrual Health Two workshops conducted this year resulted in improved menstrual health, with many students reporting a reduction or complete relief from symptoms such as headaches, stomach pain, and body aches. Individual one-on-one sessions with facilitators addressed both mental and physical well-being.
- **Communicative English Workshop** Encouraged students to use simple English sentences, **overcoming stage fright** and improving their ability to express themselves confidently.
- Interactive Learning Approach Trainers incorporated activities and games to make language learning more engaging and effective.
- Computer Training Focused primarily on degree students to enhance their digital literacy and employability. Three batches of training were successfully conducted.

Additional Program Activities & Engagements

- Six training sessions and three financial assistance programs were conducted.
- Health & Wellness: Eye check-up camp was organized for Payana students and their mothers.
- **Skill Development for Mothers:** A special session was conducted by **RAPID** to enhance skills among Payana mothers.
- **Exposure Trip:** Four students participated in an **educational trip to Bengaluru**, broadening their learning experience.

Measurable Impact & Achievements

• Increased confidence levels among participants.

- Improved initiative-taking and leadership skills.
- Enhanced communication skills and ability to interact effectively.
- Greater self-pride, awareness of personal hygiene, diet, and exercise.

Operating Highlights: Coaching for competitive exams in collaboration with Sathi

Objective of the program

The objective of this program is to identify the academically merited students from government schools and from small towns or rural areas and provide them academic support so that they can grow and achieve well academically. The students selected, coached have high potential and they have achieved excellent results at 10^{th} and subsequently at 12^{th} std. The coaching for the students is in 2 levels.

- 1. Coaching the students during $9^{\rm th}$ & $10^{\rm th}$ std. for competitive exams like Tapas and Saadhana
- 2. Preparing students in 8th std. from the Govt. Schools for NMMS Exam

The program expanded its reach to students from Karnataka, Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Tamil Nadu, Uttarakhand, Bihar, and Haryana, offering high-quality coaching and academic resources.

• Class 10 Coaching

- o **33 students continued into Class 10** from the 2023-24 batches.
- Based on their performance, all students are expected to score above 95% in their board exams, with at least 18 students achieving above 98% in 2025.

• Class 9 Coaching

- o The program reached out to **over 1,000 students across nine states** that scored above **100 marks in the NMMS exam**, connecting with them via phone and mail.
- 567 applications were received, and 253 students participated in an online screening test.
- Following final interviews, 165 students were selected, though 75 students continued till the end of March 2025 after natural attrition.

Innovative Coaching Model

• Daily Online Classes:

- Coaching began in June 2024, incorporating Spoken English training and Math revision to build strong conceptual foundations.
- Students attended one-hour daily sessions via Google Meet (6:30 PM 7:30 PM), with an interactive format where each student actively participated.
- Students received 30-35 preparatory questions daily, ensuring rigorous practice and engagement.
- Faculty emphasized conceptual learning, encouraging active discussions and personalized guidance.

• Academic Resources:

Each student received a set of NCERT Exemplar Books for Grades
 7-10 (Math & Science).

- Students were also provided NTSE Preparation Books (MTG Publication), containing five years of previous exam questions across Math, Physics, Chemistry, and Biology.
- Educational Camps & Exposure Visits
 In-person educational camps were organized at three locations to provide additional learning experiences and career guidance:
- Pune, Maharashtra (December 2024)
- Bangalore, Karnataka (January 2025)
- Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh (March 2025)

Key Highlights:

- Personal interactions **strengthened trust**, reinforcing the program's credibility among students and parents.
- **Career guidance sessions** helped students explore higher education opportunities and scholarships.
- **Exposure visits** to premier institutions inspired students and broadened their career perspectives.
- **Hands-on science experiment sessions** provided practical learning experiences.

Looking Ahead

With the continued support of our donors and partners, the Sathi-Nurture Merit Program aims to expand its reach, empowering even more high-potential students from rural and underserved backgrounds. By investing in these young minds, we are shaping the next generation of scholars, leaders, and changemakers.


